ABTC Is Excited to Announce the Certified Transplant Preservationist (CTP) Examination Program

In response to requests from the profession, ABTC is currently developing the CTP examination with the goal of beginning to administer the examination in early fall 2009. ABTC will prepare more detailed information once the examination is set to launch.

Quick Facts

Qualifications for sitting the examination

One full year work experience in organ preservation – this includes a full consecutive twelve months of organ preservation (does not have to be full time work responsibilities)

Examination administration

The examination will be administered using the same assessment centers currently available for the CCTC, CPTC and CCTN examinations (with the exception of international candidates).

Examination Content & Length

A full examination content will be available on the ABTC website shortly. However the major content areas of the CTP examination are: Professional Practice, Organ Recovery, Aseptic Technique, Organ Preservation, Specimen Collection, Packing, Shipping & Labeling. The examination is 100 scored questions.

Recertification

CTP certificants will be required to recertify every three years by collecting 60 Continuing Education Points for Transplant Certification (CEPTCs) or by re-examination.

Examination Cost

The Board set the CTP examination fee at \$425 comparable to all other ABTC examination programs.
